How to Sign-up for FASTtech Classes

Step One: Apply for Admission

- a. Before you register for a class, you must be admitted to Foothill College. There is no fee to apply.
If you were admitted the previous quarter, skip this step, and go to Step Two
- b. Go to the Admission and Registration page on the Foothill College website at:

- c. On the Admission and Registration page, click the **Apply for Admission** link.
- d. On the Application for Admission page, click the **Begin Application for Foothill College** button (bottom).
- e. If you are a *new user*, create your free account that will allow you to choose a username and password login.
- f. If you are a *continuing user*, use your username and password to login.
- g. Follow the prompts to complete your application. *Make a note of your Student ID Number and PIN.*

Step Two: Register for FASTtech (Learning in new media LINC) classes

Once you've filled out your application, a Campus-wide ID (CWID) will be sent to you via email and you will be able to register for classes at <https://myportal.fhda.edu>. The first time you login, your password will be your date of birth MMDDYY. (For additional login information, you can go to: https://myportal.fhda.edu/site/loginguide/login_guide.html)

- a. Once logged in, click the “**Registration**” tab.
- b. Click “**Add or Drop Classes**”.
- c. Choose “**Foothill College**”.
- d. Choose the quarter for which you would like to enroll.
- e. Click “**Class Search**”.
- f. Choose “**Learning in New Media Class**”.
- g. Click “**View Sections**” for classes wanted.
- h. Select the class and then click “**Register**”.

Step Three: Pay Fees

- a. Once you're registered, you must pay for the class within five days to avoid being dropped from the class for non-payment. Go to the Registration tab on **MyPortal** and click on “**Make a Payment**” and then choose the Terms.
- b. Optional Fees: Some fees such as Student Representation and Student ID card fees (<http://foothill.edu/reg/fees.php>) are optional for FASTtech students. You can call the Cashier's Office to have these fees waived/reduced:
